State the major coaching points a teacher should emphasize when teaching

- the following gymnastics skills to beginners:
  i) The front roll. [3 marks]

  ii) The back roll. [3 marks]
  - iii) The head stand. [3 marks]iv) The handstand [3 marks]
  - b) Assuming that each skill in 1a) has been mastered, describe how you would enrich each of the skills. [13 marks]
- 2. A coach is given six mats and 1 trampette to introduce the theme of flight to a group of 14 students in 2 hours.
  - a) Describe how the coach can use the Command Style to achieve his/her objective. [15 marks]
  - b) Enumaerate major technical errors the coach can anticipate in such a session. [5marks]
  - c) State how the mistakes listed in 2b) can be corrected. [5 marks]
- 3. Safety is an important consideration in gymnastics sessions. Using the context of educational gymnastics and trampoline, describe the measures a coach should take to ensure the safety of students during lessons. [25 marks]
- 4 Discuss Laban's principles of movement as they relate to gymnastics. [25 marks]

- 5. a) Fear hinders performance in gymnastics, especially in those who start learning gymnastics late in life. Describe strategies that a teacher should use to reduce fear in beginner Gymnasts who are 20 years old and above. [15 marks]
  - b) Gymnastics performance is motivated by success. How can a coach taking a class of mixed ability in gymnastics ensure that all students experience success. [10 marks]
- 6. a) Present a set of graded activities that a teacher can use to teach trampolining to a group of 13 beginner trampolinists. Assume that the teacher is given 1 trampoline and five, two hour sessions. [15 marks]
  - b) Discuss mistakes to be expected from such a group of students.. [10 marks]
