b) Which factors contributed to the revival of the Olympic Games by Pierre de Coubertin? (15 marks)
4. a) Identify the symbols of the Olympic Movement. (5 marks)
b) For each of the symbols identified in 4(a) above write brief notes clearly explaining what it symbolizes or what it means, when it was invented, and when it was adopted and used by I.O.C. (20 marks)
5. In the promotion of fair play critically examine the role played by each of the following people involved in sport:
 - a) Participants (5 marks)
 - b) Educators (5 marks)
 - c) Coaches (5 marks)
 - d) Officials (5 marks)
 - e) Parents (5 marks)
6. a) Which factors would indicate a commitment by an organization to eliminate discrimination in sports? (12 marks)
b) What is the basis of the fair and ethical conduct of sport? (13 marks)
