




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ABSTRACT

This project is based on a research done by the student at Kadoma Textiles Dyehouse Division. It was prompted by the investigation done by the student as part of her assignment diring her industrial attachment period. These investigations revealed to management that some losses or shortages of fabric where occurring during processing and had not been noticed. Hence the student had to find a way of improving the company's materials control system which is cost effective but first some investigations had to be carried out to try and establish the possible cause of these losses.
