Using the "onion method" rewrite the following intros.

- a) In Singapore, a woman dies after eating Slim 10, which are appetite suppressant pills. The pills contained fenfluramine, a substance banned there since 1997 for its possible effects. The packages containing the pills did not say they contained fenfluramine. They were imported into Singapore by Semon Liu and company. The police are now investigating charges of illegally importing the drug, and of selling a banned substance against the company. The woman was named Rani Raja. She was 43, and died of liver failure. Her doctors suspect the liver failure was caused by fenfluramine.
- b) Kader Asmal addresses the parliamentary portfolio committee on education about his plans to rationalize universities and technicons. He says that students must pay their fees. But at the same time, the institutions themselves have debt that could cripple them. It's like an albatross around their necks. The government may have to forgive some of its debt, he says.
